

ESSENTIALITY CERTIFICATE

This is to certify that there is presently a need to start the B.Sc.(Nursing) College. At present, there are 15 Nursing Colleges in the State of Maharashtra and have 493 admission seats in all B.Sc. Nursing colleges. The ratio of the B.Sc. Nurses to the population of Maharashtra is 1:176840. At present there are 12 B.Sc. Nursing Colleges having only 383 admission capacity in the Rest of Maharashtra region. Hence, it is desirable to grant permission to start a new B.Sc. Nursing College with annual intake capacity of 50 students at " **Jawahar Medical Foundation, College of Nursing, Sakri Road, Dist-Dhule.** " in State of Maharashtra.

2. This certificate is being given on the condition that, **Jawahar Medical Foundation, Dhule.** will fulfil the norms and conditions laid down by the Nursing Council of India, New Delhi and the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik and will not employ / engage any teacher from the Government Nursing College except on their retirement at superannuation.
