Laling, Dhule, hereinafter called the "SETTLOR" (which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to context be deemed to include his executors, administrators and representatives) of the ONE PART and (1) Dr. SHRI BHAIKAS CHUDAMAN PATIL, Lane No. 4, Dhule, Chairman, (2) Dr. SHRI VISHWAS CHUDAMAN PATIL, Lane No. 4, Dhule, Secretary, (3) SHRI BALASAHEB alias SHRI BERNATH VITTHALRAO VIKHE PATIL, Pravara-Nagar, Shreerampur, Ahmednagar, (4) SHRI BALMUKUND PASARI, Parola Road, Dhule, (5) SMT. 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howsoever in relation to these presents) upon the Trust and with and subject to the powers, provisions, agreements and declaration, hereinafter declared and contained of and concerning the same.

(2) The name of the Trust shall be " JAWAHAR MEDICAL FOUNDATION ", and its activities shall extend to whole of the India.

(3) The objects for which the Trust Fund is established are medical education, medical research, medical relief to the public and any other object incidental and related to medical education, medical research and medical relief to the public in general in India and for this :

(a) To establish, maintain, run and or grant aid in cash and or in kind to medical schools, medical colleges

(g) To establish, maintain and/or run studentships, scholarships and render other kind of aid to individuals and students, including provisions of medicines, books, stipends, medals and other incentives for promoting medical research and advancement of medical knowledge and education without distinction of caste, creed and religion.


(h) To conduct scientific research in basic sciences in relation to medicinal, clinical and applied medicines, nutrition and any other problem related to community health and medical aid.

5 The Trustees shall cause true and accurate accounts to be kept of all monies received and spent and of all matters in respect thereof in the course of management of trust properties or in relation to the carrying out of the objects and purposes of the trust as well as of all assets credits and effects of the Trust properties.

6 For the furtherance of the objects of the Trust and in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act for the investment or use of the Trust Funds for the time being in force, the trustees will have the following powers :

(a) To accept any donation, contribution, grant or subscription in cash or in kind from any person, Government, semi Government institution, body of persons, trust etc. with or without conditions.

(b) To apply the whole or part of the income of the


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his or their place.

(j) To appoint or make provisions for the appointment of any person (including all or any of the trustees and committees or administrators or Managing Trustees or otherwise) for the purpose of administration of the trust in such manner and subject to such rules, regulations as the Trustees may prescribe and also to appoint or provide for the appointment of separate Trustees to hold any fund or investment subject to the provisions of the deed in such manner subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustees may from time to time think fit.

(k) To make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust.

(l) To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any public charitable institution for the achievement of the objects of the Trust and to impose any conditions to any subscription or donation made by them.

(m) To set apart and/or allocate the whole or part of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.

(n) To join, cooperate or amalgamate this Trust with other or others having similar objects upon such terms and conditions as the trustees may in their discretion think fit, particularly having regard to and in conformity with the object and nature of this Trust.

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liberty to appoint additional Trustees within the number mentioned above for such period or on such terms as to retirement and reappointment as the trustees for the time being consider proper. If any trustee dies, retires or becomes unfit or incapable to act, the continuing or surviving Trustee or Trustees shall be competent to appoint a trustee in place of the trustees dying, retiring or becoming unfit or incapable to act. The decision for appointment of the new trustee shall be taken by majority of the continuing or surviving Trustee or trustees. A person shall cease to be a Trustee either (i) if he without leave of absence does not attend three consecutive meetings of the Trustees or for one calendar year which ever is longer, or (ii) if he is requested to resign by majority.


12 Every Trustee shall be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his intention to do so.

13 The Trustees may from time to time frame rules for conduct and regulation of the meetings of Trustees in the absence of such regulations :-

(a) Two trustees shall form a quorum for the meeting of the Trustees

(b) All matters shall be decided by the trustees mutually by majority of the trustees present of the meeting,

(c) Resolution passed without any meeting of the trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of majority of existing trustees


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trust with the help of salaried employees as per policies and directives laid down by the Board of Trustees.

16 The Secretary shall through the employees of the Trust look after the accounts, arrange for the meetings of the Board of Trustees, record the proceeding of the meetings in the minute book, deal with the correspondence of the trust as per direction, guidance and instructions of the Chairman and shall assist the Chairman in the management of the trust as per the advice of the Chairman.

17 The Trustees shall have the power and their uncontrolled discretion, instead of acting personally, to employ and pay an agent (including any Bank) to transact any business or to do any act whatsoever in relation to the trust of these presents, including the receipts and payments of moneys without being liable for loss and shall be entitled to be allowed and paid all charges and expenses incurred thereby.

18 The Trustees may delegate in writing all or any of his powers, under these presents to his nominee who will be entitled so long as such nomination remains in force, to exercise such powers in the same manner as the trustees himself could do personally.

19 The Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any money or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of such capital or income any expenses or outgoings ought to be paid or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusive.

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(c) To establish, promote, manage, organise or maintain any branch of the Trust or any other Trust or its branch with objects similar to those of this Trust and to promote or carry out affiliation or amalgamation of such other trust with this trust.

(d) To take over, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing institution having objects, similar to the objects of this trust on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.

(e) To transfer all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagements of this Trust to any one or of the Trusts or institutions with which this trust is authorised to amalgamate.


23 The accounting year of the Trust shall be ending on 31st March every year.

24 These Trust Funds shall be and remain irrevocable for all times.

25 The office of the Trust shall be situated at unless changed by the Trustees by two third majority.

26 It is expressly declared that no part of the trust property or its income or Trust Fund shall be applied for any purpose outside India or for any purpose which is not a public charitable purpose in law and all provisions hereof shall be construed accordingly.

9. PP shall comply the following guidelines published by the CPCB on February-2019 regarding handling of BMW for utilization

1. HCE shall preferably handover Bio-medical wastes such as pleural fluid, ascetic fluid, HBsAG positive blood, placenta etc. to the Pharmaceutical industry / Biotechnology firms for production of drugs, reagent chemicals, markers etc. if any such as Pharmaceutical industry / Biotechnology firm approaches them for the same. If there are any difficulties in the matter, the same may be communicated to such firm and copied to the board also.
2. HCE shall strictly follow the procedure for packaging & transportation of Bio-medical Wastes such as pleural fluid, ascetic fluid, HBsAG positive blood, placenta etc. to the Pharmaceutical industry / Biotechnology firms as per the guidelines of CPCB published in Feb-2019 for "Handling of BMW for utilization".
3. HCEs shall submit the report to the Board office about type, quantity and frequency of handling over such BMW on yearly basis.
4. Industry to enter into legal agreement with HCE's and inform the MPC Board and competent authority of State Public Health Department about such collection of BMW along with quantity and type of waste collected.
5. In case of any technical difficulty towards handing over the required BMW, you shall inform to the Board accordingly.
6. HCEs shall properly dispose and handover the waste to authorized user / facilities having valid consent to operate from MPCB.

10. This consent is issued subject to conditions mentioned below:

- a. The "authorized Person" shall comply with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the Rules made there under.
- b. Any unauthorized change in equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of this Authorization.
- c. You shall submit details of Management and Handling of outdated, discarded, unused Cytotoxic drugs generated in the Cancer centers, research and healthcare in the format prescribed by CPCB which is available on www.cpcb.nic.in along with Annual Report to MPCB with a copy to CPCB before 31st January every year.
- d. You shall manage the Mercury Waste in the HCE in environmentally sound manner (including storage, spilled collection, transportation and disposal) as per CPCB guidelines published on CPCB website www.cpcb.nic.in dated: 07.09.2010 as detailed in document entitled "Environmentally Sound Management of Mercury Waste in Health Care Facilities".
- e. You shall ensure phase out of chlorinated plastic bags, gloves and blood bags by HCEs within two years.
- f. You shall establish Bar code system within one year.
- g. You shall ensure that the liquid waste is treated and disposed by all the occupier or operator of a CBWTF in accordance with the Water Act, 1974;
- h. You shall maintain day to day basis and display the monthly record Including Annual report on its website within two years from the date of Notification.
- i. You shall submit separate Bank Guarantees towards compliance of condition mentioned at Annexure - IV to Regional Office, within 30 days.
- j. You shall submit compliance of Bank Guarantee conditions every six months to Regional Officer, for verification purpose.

- k. You shall submit application for renewal of Combined Consent and Biomedical Waste authorization before 120 days along with appropriate fees.
11. This Board reserves the right to review, amend, suspend, revoke etc. this consent and the same shall be binding on the industry.
 12. This consent should not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary NOC/permission from any other Government agencies.
 13. The Board reserves the right to review, amend, suspend, revoke this consent and the same shall be binding on the industry.
 14. This consent should not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary NOC/permission from any other Government authorities.
 15. This consent is issued pursuant to the decision of the 6th Consent Appraisal Committee Meeting held on 03.12.2020.
 16. PP shall install primary ETP for the treatment of trade effluent within six months.
 17. The applicant shall make an application for renewal of consent 60 days prior to date of expiry of the consent. (Operate/Renewal)

B) The Applicant shall operate the effluent treatment plant (ETP) to treat the trade effluent so as to achieve the following standards prescribed by the Board or under EP Act, 1986 and Rules made there under from time to time, whichever is stringent:

B) The Applicant shall operate the sewage treatment system to treat the sewage so as to achieve the following standards.

C) The treated sewage shall be recycled for secondary purposes to the maximum extent and remaining shall be discharged on land for gardening within premise after confirming above standards. In no case, sewage shall find its way for gardening/outside factory premises.

The Board reserves its rights to review plans, specifications or other data relating to plant setup for the treatment of waterworks for the purification there of & the system for the disposal of sewage or trade effluent or in connection with the grant of any consent conditions. The Applicant shall obtain prior consent of the Board to take steps to establish the unit or establish any treatment and disposal system or an extension or addition thereto.
4. The industry shall ensure replacement of pollution control system or its parts after expiry of its expected life as defined by manufacturer so as to ensure the compliance of standards and safety of the operation thereof.
5. The Applicant shall comply with the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and as amended, by installing water meters and other provisions as contained in the said act:

5. Conditions for D.G. Set
- Noise from the D.G. Set should be controlled by providing an acoustic enclosure or by treating the room acoustically.
 - Industry should provide acoustic enclosure for control of noise. The acoustic enclosure/ acoustic treatment of the room should be designed for minimum 25 dB (A) Insertion loss or for meeting the ambient noise standards, whichever is on higher side. A suitable exhaust muffler with insertion loss of 25 dB (A) shall also be provided. The measurement of insertion loss will be done at different points at 0.5 meters from acoustic enclosure/room and then average.
 - Industry should make efforts to bring down noise level due to DG set, outside industrial premises, within ambient noise requirements by proper siting and control measures.
 - Installation of DG Set must be strictly in compliance with recommendations of DG Set manufacturer.
 - A proper routine and preventive maintenance procedure for DG set should be set and followed in consultation with the DG manufacturer which would help to prevent noise levels of DG set from deteriorating with use.

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- f) D.G. Set shall be operated only in case of power failure.
- g) The applicant should not cause any nuisance in the surrounding area due to operation of D.G. Set.

SCHEDULE-IV

General Conditions:

1. You shall provide facility for collection of environmental samples and samples of trade and sewage effluents, air emissions and hazardous waste to the Board staff at the terminal or designated points and shall pay to the Board for the services rendered in this behalf.
2. You should monitor effluent quality, stack emissions, noise and ambient air quality quarterly
3. You shall provide ports in the chimney/(s) and facilities such as ladder, platform etc. for monitoring the air emissions and the same shall be open for inspection to/and for use of the Board's Staff. The chimney(s) vents attached to various source so emission shall be designated by numbers such as S-1, S-2, etc. and these shall be painted/ displayed to facilitate identification.
4. Whenever due to any accident or other unforeseen act or even, such emissions occur or is apprehended to occur in excess of standards laid down, such information shall be forthwith Reported to Board, concerned Police Station, office of Directorate of Health Services, Department of Explosives, Inspectorate of Factories and Local Body. In case of failure of pollution control equipments, the production process connected to it shall be stopped.
5. You shall provide an alternate electric power source sufficient to operate all pollution control facilities installed to maintain compliance with the terms and conditions of the consent. In the absence, the applicant shall stop, reduce or otherwise, control production to abide by terms and conditions of this consent.
6. You shall submit, the Environmental Statement Report for the financial year ending 31st March in the prescribed Form-V as per the provisions of rule 14 of the Environment (Protection) (Second Amendment) Rules, 1992 to Regional Office, the 30th day of September every year.
7. You shall recycle/reprocess/reuse/recover Hazardous Waste as per the provision contain in the HW(MH&TM)Rules 2008, which can be recycled/processed/reused /recovered and only waste which has to be incinerated shall go to incineration and waste which can be used for land filling and cannot be recycled/reprocessed etc should go for that purpose, in order to reduce load on incineration and landfill site/environment.
8. You shall comply with the Hazardous Waste (M, H & TM) Rules, 2008 and submit the Annual Returns to RO- as per Rule 5(6) & 22(2) of Hazardous Waste (M, H & TM) Rules, 2008 for the preceding year April to March in Form-IV by 30th June of every year.
9. An inspection book shall be opened and made available to the Board's officers during their visit to the HCE.
10. You shall strictly comply with the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974, Air (P&CP) Act, 1981 and Environmental Protection Act, 1986 and industry specific standard under EP Rules 1986 which are available on MPCB website (www.mpcb.gov.in).
11. You shall constitute an Environmental cell with qualified staff/personnel/agency to see the day to day compliance of consent & authorization condition towards Environment Protection.
12. Separate drainage system shall be provided for collection of trade and sewage effluents. Terminal manholes shall be provided at the end of the collection system with arrangement for measuring the flow. No effluent shall be admitted in the pipes/sewers downstream of the terminal manholes. No effluent shall find its way other than in designed and provided collection system.

13. Neither storm water nor discharge from other premises shall be allowed to mix with the effluents from the HCE.
14. You shall install a separate meter showing the consumption of energy for operation of domestic and industrial effluent treatment plants and air pollution control system. A register showing consumption of chemicals used for treatment shall be maintained.
15. You should not cause any nuisance in surrounding area.
16. You shall take adequate measures for control of noise levels from its own sources within the premises so as to maintain ambient air quality standard in respect of noise to less than 75 dB (A) during day time and 70 dB (A) during night time. Day time is reckoned in between 6 a.m. and 10 p.m. and night time is reckoned between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
17. You shall maintain good housekeeping.
18. You shall bring minimum 33% of the available open land under green coverage/ plantation. The applicant shall submit a yearly statement to Regional Office by 30th September every year on available open plot area, number of trees surviving as on 31st March of the year and number of trees planted by September end.
19. The non-hazardous solid waste arising in the factory premises, sweepings, etc. be disposed of scientifically so as not to cause any nuisance / pollution. The applicant shall take necessary permissions from civic authorities for disposal of solid waste.
20. You shall not change or alter the quantity, quality, the rate of discharge, temperature or the mode of the effluent/emissions or hazardous wastes or control equipments provided for without previous written permission of the Board. You will not carry out any activity, for which this consent has not been granted/without prior consent of the Board.
21. You shall submit Six Monthly statement in respect of obligation towards consent and pollution control compliance's duly supported with documentary evidences (format can be downloaded from MPCB official site).
22. You shall submit official e-mail address and any change will be duly informed to the MPCB, forthwith.
23. You shall achieve the National Ambient Air Quality standards prescribed vide Government of India, Notification dtd. 16.11.2009 as amended
24. You shall observe provisions of E-waste (Management and Handling) Rules 2011 and Battery Waste(Management and Handling)Rules2001, as amended.
